In seminary, students use paper scriptures. The use of cell phones is not allowed, unless the teacher asks for research, or scripture marking to be done. Cell phones and technology do have their place with Gospel Learning, but with 50 minutes of learning time, it is important to keep students focused on the Gospel topic they are discussing in class. Paper scriptures can be purchased through LDS Distribution services.

Beginning this school year, seminary study will support Come Follow Me, home gospel study. This year the students will be studying the four Gospels of the New Testament until January, and then begin with the Book of Mormon for the entire 2020 year, January to December.

Along with that study, the students learn the nine doctrines of the church and their corresponding scriptures.

Requirements for seminary are 75% attendance, 75% on two assessments, and read all four books of scripture by the end of their senior year.
